

The "Business & Industry" section on the CTO Innovation website is tailored for companies aiming to work with the DoD. This section provides insights into critical technology areas, manufacturing partnerships, and prototyping opportunities, enabling SBIR companies to align their innovations with DoD needs.

Navigate to the Business and Industry Tab and select the "find them here" button. Companies are asked to complete a form to narrow down the available resources.
